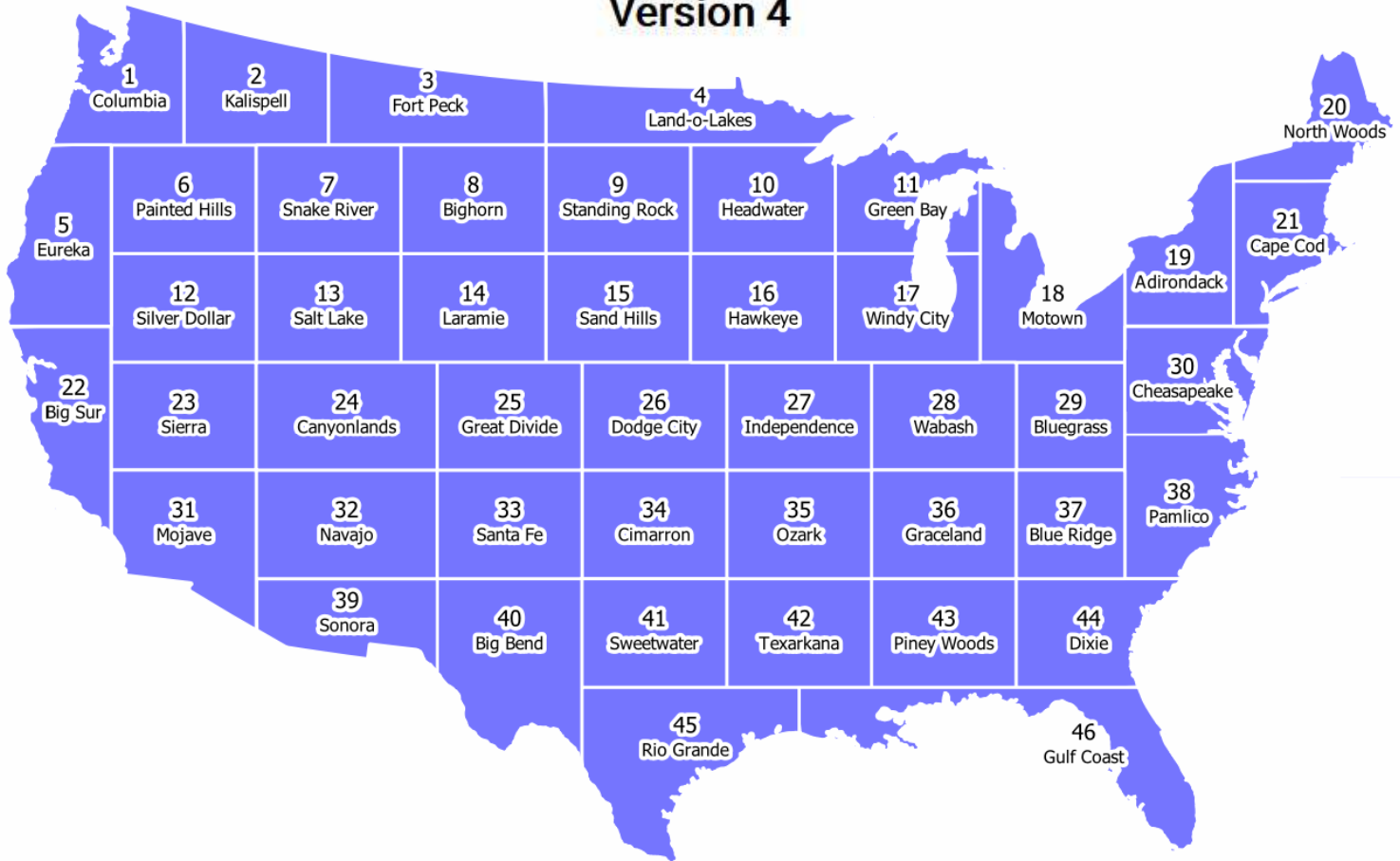




## The National Hazard and Risk Model for Wildfire Version 4



### Shapefile Distribution Plan

All component files of a shapefile are limited to a maximum size of 2 GB. No-HARM is therefore divided into 46 separate "chunks" for distribution in this format. The chunks are roughly equal in size (on disk) and will fit together perfectly to create a seamless tessellation of the landscape from coast to coast. They are numbered and also have short, iconic names as a convenient way to identify their general location. These names and numbers appear only in file names and have no other significance or meaning within the No-HARM model itself:
